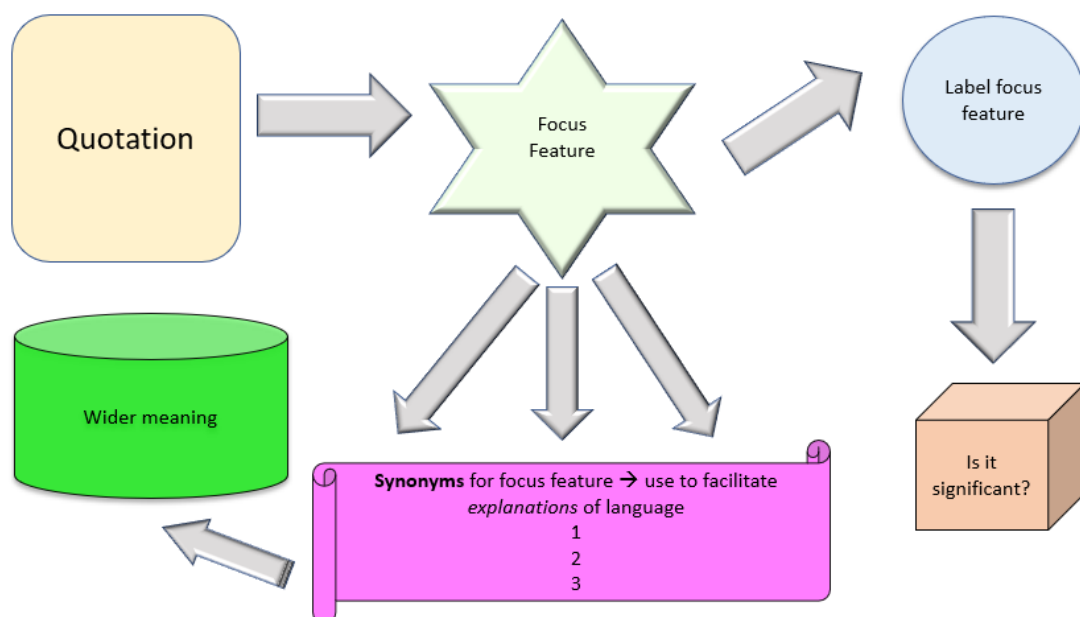


## Y13 English Language – Revision Checklist

- Ensure that you know your AO1 terms – focus on clause types and the AO1 mat handed out in September.
- Use the Theory grids to revise over key ideas for each topic.
  - Remember – there will definitely be questions on CLA (P1, Q4+5), and Language Change (P2, Q2).
- On each paper, there will be two texts for you to read, so practising reading articles to develop speed reading skills is essential. You should be reading one article from the Guardian every day.

### Suggested, chunked revision activities:

- Select an article of interest from The Guardian online - (<https://www.theguardian.com/uk?scrllybrkr=b0470b8c>). Highlight a few paragraphs and annotate:
  - Representations
  - Linguistic terms
- Read over the notes in your exercise book. Try to condense them to one sheet of A4.
- Make revision cards for all of the linguistic terms you have studied so far.
- Have a go at writing a PETAL paragraph that analyses a section of an article. Self-assess it by highlighting all of the AO1 terms you have used in one colour. Then highlight all of the links to CRAMP that you have made in another colour.
- Test yourself on the key terminology. With a partner, ask them to ask you for the definitions of 10 key terms.
- Complete a language analysis map using an article from The Guardian.
  - (Analysis map attached below)
- Read two texts that cover the same topic. For example, a Guardian article on Gendered Language use and a Daily Mail article gendered language use book. Make a list of the key similarities and key differences.
