Art GCSE Grade 4 or higher

Art A-level is an excellent course that allows you to be introduced to a variety of experiences, exploring a range of fine art media, techniques and processes.

During the duration of the course, you will be given the opportunities to explore drawing and painting using a variety of methods and media on a variety of scales. All ideas and development work will be recorded in sketchbooks and journals as well as larger scale design boards.

Within the structure of the course, you will be given the opportunity to work in one or more area(s) of Art, such as those listed below:

- ' Painting and drawing
- ' Mixed media, including collage and assemblage
- ' Sculpture
- ' Installation
- ' Textile - appliqué, machine embroidery, felt making and costume making
- ' Printmaking
- ' Film, television, animation, video, photography: Lens-based and/or light-based media and new media.

The coursework contributes to 60% of the final grade and the externally set task 40%. This final unit culminates in a 15 hour practical exam where you can really showcase the skills and knowledge you have acquired during the course.

There will also be opportunities to visit places of interest to allow you to broaden your artistic experience and understanding of the creative world.
